

ARRA Projects - IDOT State Highway System

Dollars Programmed: Around \$604 million has been programmed for 254 projects on the state highway system.

Miles/Structures Programmed: The ARRA funding will improve nearly 635 miles and 36 structures on the state highway system.

Engineering: To support the ARRA construction projects, more than \$27 million in ARRA funding is programmed for 26 engineering projects.

Construction: Through June 26, 202 construction projects had been awarded at a cost of \$426.7 million. Another 23 construction projects, with an estimated cost totaling \$75.7 million, were advertised for letting, but not yet awarded.

Jobs: So far, the \$426.7 million in construction contracts awarded are supporting 12,350 jobs, based on the FHWA estimate of 34,779 jobs resulting from every \$1.2 billion in transportation investment.
